Step 1: Contact Your Regional MCIR Office

Step 2: Determine Preferred Data Reporting Method

Electronic Medical Record (EMR) data exchange with MCIR

Manual data entry into MCIR

Step 3: Receive Required MCIR Access Authorization

- 1) Verify/Prepare MCIR access
- 2) Perform required EMR-MCIR data testing

Verify/Prepare MCIR access

Step 4: Submit Immunization Data to MCIR

Report administered and historical immunization data to MCIR

Step 5: Enjoy the Benefits

- An abundant source of data: over 44.9 million adult vaccination records and 64 million child records currently in MCIR
- Over 6,000 immunizing providers submit data to MCIR
- Access to comprehensive patient immunization data and assessments, based on immunization data compiled by participating providers and retail pharmacies
- Improved patient care
- Ability to send immunization data electronically from an EMR to MCIR and receive Meaningful Use incentives (if eligible)
- Improved vaccine inventory management
